### About the Job

The Thoroughbred Racing Protective Bureau is a wholly-owned subsidiary of the Thoroughbred Racing Associations of North America, a trade organization comprised of 44 Thoroughbred racing associations located throughout North America. Founded in 1946, TRPB is responsible for providing its corporate ownership, and select clientele on a commercial basis, with specialized security, investigative, analytic, and information management services. TRPB represents a unified effort by TRA-member racetrack associations to maintain high standards, protect the legitimate business interests and integrity of the sport, and foster and maintain public confidence.

TRPB is currently seeking a Wagering Analyst to join its team.

### Position Purpose

The Wagering Analyst position is located within TRPB's Wagering Integrity Unit, and reports directly to the TRPB Director of Wagering Analysis. The Wagering Analyst will oversee analytic processes and products associated with TRPB's Betting Analysis Platform, which facilitates the collection of wagering information on a near real-time basis, applies a number of autonomous processes to identify wagering events requiring further analysis or investigation, and delivers integrity tools to monitor wagering and participant activity.

### Essential Duties and Responsibilities

#### **Your responsibilities include:**

- Oversee the day-to-day collection and importation of data requisite to facilitate the functionality of the Betting Analysis Platform

- Perform detailed analysis; as required, identify and engage logical and appropriate investigative measures; and create comprehensive reports for dissemination to racing associations and regulators regarding wagering anomalies of particular concern to the integrity of racing
- Participate in the development and implementation of technical or analytic processes which improve or expand the TRPB Betting Analysis Platform's capabilities
- Participate in the expansion and refinement of TRPB's web-based portal, through which TRPB delivers its wagering integrity products
- Serve as a technical resource for TRPB's wagering integrity toolset by responding to user queries; providing user on-site training; and participating in industry seminars or workshops upon request
- Ensure that operational processes and procedures support TRPB's strategic objectives

### **Required Skills and Experience**

**To be successful in this position, it will require the following skill set:**

- Bachelor's degree (B.S./B.A.) from an accredited four-year college or university
- Proven experience in the horse racing industry, to include experience in pari-mutuel wagering operations (tote), simulcast operations, or racetrack management
- Ability to analyze racing industry-related data, including various forms of wagering data (e.g., pari-mutuel and exchange betting) and racing participant past-performance data
- Proficiency in Microsoft applications (Excel, Access, Word); experience in Crystal reports helpful
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills
- Ability to prioritize, direct and monitor multiple tasks and assignments
- Physically mobile with reasonable accommodations, including the ability to push, pull, carry and lift up to 25 pounds, and the ability to push, pull, reach, bend, twist, stoop, stack, crouch, kneel and balance when performing job duties in varying work areas such as confined spaces
- Must successfully undergo a thorough Personal Background Examination conducted by TRPB
